# Program of your World Tour 2024

In three weeks, the heart full of new encounters and friendships, memories, laughter, landscapes, dances and music of today or traditions of the past, you will have discovered the most beautiful golf courses and done ... around the world!

#### PANAMA

Our first flight will take us to this small Central American country, a link between the modernity of Panama Ciudad, the colonial charm of the Casco Viejo district, and its richly preserved traditions thanks to its welcoming local communities. But of course, the major attraction during our stay will be the visit to its famous canal connecting the Atlantic and the Pacific, including one of its three locks.



#### EASTER ISLAND

A tiny dot of land of 164 km<sup>2</sup> in the immensity of the Pacific Ocean, Easter Island, located 3,700 km from the Chilean coast and 4,200 km from Tahiti, is famous throughout the world for its enigmatic Moai. These are monumental statues of basalt shaped between the 13th and 14th centuries. The contrast between the destitution of the island and the extraordinary character of the culture of its inhabitants will always remain the source of mystery.





#### IGUACU

At the crossroads of Brazil, Argentina, and Paraguay, Iguaçu will allow us to dive into the heart of South America and penetrate its impressive vegetation. Stretching over more than three kilometers and with an average height of 80 meters, the falls offer a breathtaking landscape under the amused gaze of the toucans.



#### FIJI

It is after crossing the international date line, and therefore, officially aged by one day that we will land at Viti Levu, the main island of the 300 islands that make up the Fiji archipelago. A blend of Melanesian and Indian culture, this stopover will be an opportunity for an authentic discovery of villages and colorful markets. One can also relax along the clear turquoise water lagoons.

#### MELBOURNE

Melbourne, a metropolis elected various times by The Economist as one of the most pleasant cities in the world. Nicknamed "The Paris of the Antipodes," its lively neighborhoods and numerous museums give it the status of the cultural capital of Australia. #### SIEM-REAP

An absolute pride of Cambodia, the temple of Angkor Wat is the largest religious monument in the world. Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site, it bears witness to over more than 400 km<sup>2</sup> to four centuries of Khmer sovereignty. #### BALI

#### Price and Conditions of Realization:

Our prices payable in euros (€) are firm. However, they may be revised according to the conditions described below and the terms of the General Conditions of Sale of article R.211-12 of the Tourism Code in the appendix. Our prices are established with reference to the economic conditions in force on July 1, 2022, in particular for accommodations, transport, and fuel prices, various taxes, and the exchange rate of the US Dollar and the currencies of the scheduled countries. The airlines, aircraft types, and airports provided may be subject to change without notice and are quoted for information only. Similarly, certain scheduled stopovers could be replaced, canceled, or reversed depending on safety criteria or external parameters beyond the organizer's control and impossible to anticipate when the brochure is published (July 2022). The same applies to certain hotels and certain excursions, which could not ultimately be offered for reasons of force majeure. These services would be replaced by similar services at least equal to those initially planned.

The trip may be canceled if the group does not reach the minimum number of participants required according to the type of aircraft. In the event of cancelation of the trip due to lack of participants, a significant increase in the price of the trip due to the exchange rate, or the increase in particular in taxes or oil, the customer will be informed no later than 30 days before departure. The customer will have a period of 8 days from receipt of the notification to accept the new proposal or request the cancelation of their registration, which will result in the reimbursement of the sums paid by the customer. However, no compensation can be claimed. In the event of force majeure, if the trip is canceled, the customer cannot claim any compensation. The customer may not claim any reimbursement, even partial, of the transport services or other services if the latter voluntarily interrupts the trip, the only exception being the total or partial coverage by an insurance company depending on the contract subscribed and within the limit thereof only.
